In the past, we did not always communicate when we administered the then Cito tests to students. These tests are now from Leerling in Beeld. We did this because we grant the children to be able to take this as relaxed as possible and not experience any pressure.

On the other hand, there are also parents who appreciate being informed. It is nice if in those (extra) weeks it can be taken into account that the children have sufficient rest.

The tests will be taken from Monday, June 10 through Friday, June 21. It is important for our children to be able to take these tests without pressure. These tests are a tool for us to arrive at objective data. These results are analyzed and help us to see how we are doing and where we may need to adjust. We are especially curious to see what they can do without us and what they need extra support and practice for in the near future so that we can better adjust our offer if necessary.
