### General Parents' evening

On Tuesday evening, September 10, is our general parents' evening. We think it is very important that you are well informed about what we do at school and where you can help your child. What are the focus points for that year and what can you possibly do at home. This evening we will inform you about this. We have deliberately scheduled the parents' evening early in the year so that we can get off to a good start together with you. The week after are the start talks. These are also important, but you as a parent will have the floor. See also later in the newsletter.

### Inputs and exits

Herewith once again the arrangements for entering and leaving the school.

All children enter through the main entrance and then go directly to their classrooms or join the line to go upstairs (applies to grades 4-8).

After school, preschool children leave school through the emergency door adjacent to their plaza. The children may not leave until the teacher has seen the child's parent/guardian.

The children of grade 3 leave the school through the back of the school building.

The rest of the children leave the school through the main entrance.

### Schoolfruit

Starting the first week of school, we will again be able to arrange fruit for three days for our children through school meals. On Wednesday, Thursday and Friday there will be a piece of fruit for each student. On the other days it is nice if you can bring fruit.



### Staffing and formation

Just before the summer vacations, Miss Yvonne decided to leave Cloverleaf. We thank her for her commitment and wish her the best of luck!

Master Ferhaad is going to work five days instead of four. We are very happy about this because it strengthens the continuity in the group. Teacher Lakeisha will no longer teach group 3/4 on that day. She will, for the time being, teach group 7 on

Wednesdays for one day. Miss Marga will teach the other four days.

## New logo on the building

Besides the hard work in the school to prepare for classes, we have not been idle concerning the building. Before the summer vacations we presented the new school logo to you. This is now also placed on the building.

## Schooltimes

The children can enter from 8:20 am. **Class starts at 8:30.** Also on behalf of the teachers a request that your child be at school in plenty of time for the class to

start at 8:30. If children regularly come in late they will miss the start and in addition the group that has already started with the teacher will be disturbed.

At 8:30 the classroom door closes. Your child is on time if he/she is in the classroom before the 8:30 a.m. bell without a coat on. Children who are still busy with their coats will wait in the hallway until they are called inside. Children who enter at the time the bell has already rung or after the bell has rung must report to Master Wijnand and Master Kenneth. They will be given a card to take to class which must be turned in to the teacher. The teacher then knows that the tardy report will be registered. Important: in case of repeated tardiness, parents will be contacted to discuss this. If the situation does not improve, Compulsory Education may be called in.

From 8:20 the door opens. Your child is then already welcome. In the interest of your child and the class we therefore want to ask you to make sure that your child is at school on time. Thanks in advance!

## Commencement talks

The purpose of these conversations is to get acquainted with each other and to start the year well and together. There is also room here to coordinate expectations in terms of maintaining contact between you and the teacher.

In the week of September 16, the initial interviews will take place at school. These conversations last about 10 minutes. You can see it as a reverse ten minute conversation where you as a parent / caretaker are mainly talking. It is the intention that your child is also present during this conversation.

During these ten minutes there is time to get acquainted and tell the teacher about your child. What does the teacher need to know about your child?

What does your child like to do?

What are your child's talents?

Starting Monday, September 9, you can register for the kick-off meeting with your child's teacher. This is done through the Social Schools app. You have one week, namely until Friday, September 13, 4 p.m., to register.

## Important info and data, Social Schools

In the Social Schools app, you can find important dates, such as vacations, study days (that's when the children are off) and half-day classes (at the bottom right under "calendar"). These were shared with you at the end of last school year. See again below. In the newsletters you can also always find the most important information again under the first heading agenda.



It is important that you are easily accessible through Social Schools. Therefore, the recommendation is to download the app. Newsletters, messages from teachers and invitations and sign up for teacher interviews all go through this medium. If you are having trouble with this please stop by school and we will help you with this.
